



Provincial Malaria Coordinator

Job Summary:

RTI is currently accepting applications for a Provincial Malaria Coordinator in Thailand. This position is for the USAID-funded Country Health Information Systems and Data Use program (CHISU) in Thailand, implemented by JSI Research & Training Institute, Inc. with RTI International (RTI), Vital Strategies, Macro-Eyes, Jembi Health Systems, and Global Evaluation and Monitoring Network for Health (GEMNet-Health).

CHISU supports the Thailand Ministry of Public Health (MOPH) in the final stretch of eliminating malaria in the country. Thailand has set the national goal of zero local malaria transmission by 2024 and has met the criteria for inclusion in the World Health Organization's E-2025 initiative, a program for countries that are on the cusp of eliminating malaria.

Reporting to the Resident Advisor, the Provincial Malaria Coordinator will perform a range of tasks to support malaria outbreak response activities in Thailand's provinces, with a focus on border provinces. These activities will include coordinating with provinces to strengthen malaria surveillance systems, implementing and evaluating malaria prevention and containment interventions, and supporting case finding. In addition, the candidate will support provincial programs to generate, analyze, and use clinical and epidemiological data to inform health policy and response activities. The analyses may be included in provincial strategic planning or scientific articles and presentations in strategic regional and international conferences. The Provincial Malaria Coordinator will also lead and support capacity strengthening activities to improve the utilization of data for health policy and practice. This position will also participate in meetings, trainings, and workshops as required to ensure best practices and lessons learned are captured and disseminated.

This individual should have experience working with and coordinating activities with government agencies, non-governmental organizations, and other community and technical stakeholders in Thailand. Candidates must be Thai nationals. This position will be based in Bangkok, Thailand, but will require travel to provinces.

Essential Duties:

- Develop and manage relationships with government, non-governmental and other technical and community stakeholders involved in malaria response and prevention;
- Mentor subnational counterparts to conduct data analysis and use the results and methods to improve malaria control strategy and intervention implementation;
- Work with subnational counterparts to prepare for data verification;
- Assess new data analysis tools for completeness and reliability;
- Extract, clean, and analyze routine malaria data from surveillance databases, including Malaria Online and the integrated Disease Efficacy Surveillance system;
- Prepare data tabulations, reports, and presentations to support project activities;
- Support the development of scientific manuscripts on malaria outbreak management, control and elimination in Thailand;
- Contribute to project monitoring by developing and disseminating surveys and collecting and analyzing data on key indicators;
- Support preparation of quarterly progress reports on the status of project implementation; contribute to other project reports such as annual work plans;
- Participate in key meetings with DVBD, USAID, and implementing partners;
- Perform other program and project activities as assigned.

Minimum Required Education & Experience

Bachelor's Degree in biology, public health, epidemiology or biostatistics, or other related field and 8 years of experience working in global public health and malaria disease control and outbreak response, or Master's degree and 6 years of experience, or PhD and 1 year of experience, or equivalent combination of education and experience.

Skills & Abilities

- Excellent working knowledge of malaria surveillance and malaria control strategies in Thailand
- Proficiency in standard office computer applications (Office 365, MS Word, Excel, PowerPoint);
- Ability to communicate and liaise verbally and in writing with partners/vendors/suppliers/visitors and staff, and interpret/respond clearly and effectively to verbal or written instructions;
- Knowledge of USAID regulations, systems and procedures is preferred;
- Results-oriented, team player and has excellent interpersonal skills;
- Has initiative and can work with little supervision
- Ability to work independently and within matrix project and program teams
- Attention to detail and accuracy
- Culturally sensitive and respectful
- Demonstrates commitment to RTI's mission, vision, and values
