Position title: Field Supervisor (Consultant)

WorldVeg is seeking an experienced professional who will be responsible for managing the East and Southeast Asia (ESEA) regional office in Thailand, hosted by Kasetsart University (KU).

Key Responsibilities:

- A. For questionnaire interviews
 - Recruit a team of qualified survey interviewers (3-4 people) fluent in Burmese
 - Provide 1-day training to the enumerators
 - Establish contacts to local groups of migrants in Bangkok, working in different economic sectors such as services, construction, and factories
 - Create a time plan for collecting the data
 - Supervise the enumerators in the field and contribute to the interviews as needed
 - Check the quality of the data and make verify data as needed
 - Write a brief report on the data collection process
- B. For in-depth interviews
 - Recruit one translator fluent in Thai or English, and Burmese

The Person:

Required:

- Prior experience with interview-based data collection in Thai or international projects
- Excellent Thai or English, and Burmese communication skills
- Able to form a team of experienced male and female interviewers
- A background in social science or food system research is an advantage
- Able to conduct the survey in May-June 2024
