

## Terms of Reference

### Consultant to develop a SOGIESC Facilitation Guide for Classroom

#### Under HEARTS II project

Save the Children's HEARTS (Highlighting Equality and Respect Towards all SOGIESC) II project aims to ensure that LGBTIQ+ children and youth can enjoy their rights. Through child-participation in the Universal Periodic Review (UPR) process, Thailand has accepted recommendations specific to children's SOGIESC rights, including reviewing the curriculum to promote positive attitudes towards diverse SOGIESC. Additionally, HEARTS II project has been working in partnership with the Bangkok Metropolitan Administrative to promote SOGIESC inclusion in schools, leading to protection of LGBTIQ+ students.

To continue these advocacy efforts and translate the commitments to actions, there is a need to develop a SOGIESC Facilitation Guide for teachers to use in the classroom, with linkages to the Ministry of Education's Core Curriculum framework. HEARTS II project is looking for a consultant to develop a SOGIESC Facilitation Guide for Classroom.

#### **Purpose and scope of this service:**

The objective of the consultancy is to develop the SOGIESC curriculum for classroom use. The final product will be a facilitation guidance for teachers to use in their classrooms to build understanding on diverse SOGIESC. The facilitation guidance should include the linkage with the Ministry of Education's Core Curriculum framework. It should also include activities, with worksheets, that teachers can use in classrooms.

#### **Methodology:**

1. Conduct desk review, including the curriculum framework and related content regarding facilitating SOGIESC rights in classrooms.
2. Provide the first draft of Facilitation Guide with outlines.
3. Facilitate consultations with CSOs, teachers, and children.
4. Consolidate data from the consultations.
5. Develop and provide the first draft for CSOs, teachers, and children to review
6. Consolidate the feedback and finalize the Facilitation Guide
7. Present the final Facilitation Guide to stakeholders.
