ALIGHT South East Asia, the host of CSO platform is looking for consultant to support community G6PD awareness raising activities in Tak province. Main scope of consultant is to coordinate with the project's local stakeholders for activity planning, implementation, and support in gathering project's related local information, data, and updates. The project aims to support community and local health authority in Tak province through increased awareness on G6PD testing, treatment, and monitoring treatment side effects.

ALIGHT is an international non-profit organization that has provided humanitarian assistance to millions of beneficiaries over the past 40 years. ALIGHT works with refugees, IDP, and affected communities in more than ten countries around the world, helping people regain control of their lives after conflict and natural disaster. ALIGHT has been responding to the humanitarian/refugee crisis in Thailand since 1978, addressing issues relating to GBV, Health, and WASH sectors, with funding from BPRM, USAID, UNHCR, The Global Fund and many others. ALIGHT is sub-recipient of the Global Fund RAI3E grant and implementing malaria project in Thailand and Myanmar. ALIGHT is also a host of Malaria Free Mekong (regional CSO platform).

### **Roles and responsibilities of Consultant Community Coordinator**

Under the supervision of the project team, community coordinator will be responsible for the following:

- Planning of the G6PD awareness raising activities in the community in partnership with local authority and stakeholders
- Prepare awareness raising materials with guidance from the project team at ALIGHT and its partners
- Implementation of the activities in the communities in collaboration with the local health authority, village volunteers and key stakeholders in the community
- Collect information on malaria situation and risk behavior by high malaria reporting areas for targeted response
- Collect routine data of malaria and G6PD test from hospitals and local health authorities.

### **Required Experience & Qualification**

- Able to read and write in Thai or Karen language. Currently living in Tak province.
- Ability to work independently and strong teamwork spirit.
- Good at coordination, and communication.
- Strong interest, enthusiasm, and commitment to work with the community inclusively vulnerable populations.
